

## LUTHERAN THEOLOGICAL SOUTHERN SEMINARY SEMINARIAN COSTS 2008-2009

Listed below is a standard budget for the yearly cost of attendance at Lutheran Theological Southern Seminary. The expense budgets outlined in this section contain **2008-2009** fixed costs of attendance and annually adjusted estimates for other expenditures incurred by most students. While figures are generally based on full-time status, when figuring yearly costs for students enrolled part-time, the tuition is calculated at \$465 per credit hour, technology fees are \$30 per course (i.e. 9 credit hours = 3 courses x \$30) and book are an estimated \$175 per course/semester. Please review carefully and provide us with information on additional expenses as necessary.

#### **Additional Costs**

Summer Greek (tuition, housing, misc.) *Juniors*    \$3000

-OR-

Summer CPE (tuition, housing, misc.) *Middlers*    \$2580

\*-Part-time students should pro-rate the above expenses for housing, transportation and miscellaneous as follows:

**Housing** - \$2500 (6-8 credit hours); \$3750 (9-11 credit hours)

**Transportation** - \$1800 (6-8 credit hours); \$2700 (9-11 credit hours)

**Miscellaneous** - \$1350 (6-8 credit hours); \$2025 (9-11 credit hours)
