Dr. Cavanaugh is Professor of Theology at the University of St. Thomas, St. Paul, Minnesota. His degrees are from Notre Dame, Cambridge, and Duke. He is the author of five books, including most recently *The Myth of Religious Violence* (Oxford University Press, 2009). His books have been translated into French and Spanish.
