LUTHERAN THEOLOGICAL SOUTHERN SEMINARY

Listed below is a standard budget for the yearly cost of attendance at Lutheran Theological Southern Seminary. The expense budget outlines the fixed cost of attendance and annually adjusted estimates for other expenditures incurred by most students. While figures are generally based on full-time status, when figuring yearly costs for students enrolled part-time, the tuition is calculated at \$575 per credit hours, technology fees are \$30 per course and books are estimated at \$185 per course/semester.
