

Christ Chapel  
Liturgy Planning Team Instructions

THE PLANNING TEAM is responsible for the daily schedule of Christ Chapel for the assigned week [See → Dreaded Rota]. The two Senior Divinity Candidates will gather the group and prepare an overview of the week for the SACRISTY DOOR and Dr. Hawkins. Four Middlers / Senior M.A.R.s are assigned who will serve as leaders for the Monday, Tuesday, Thursday morning, and Friday liturgies. Also, four Junior seminarians are assigned to serve [*at least during the first semester*] as lectors.

THE DAILY MORNING SERVICES ARE TO BE POSTED on the sacristy door not less than the DAY before the specific liturgy to be prayed. Daily planning sheets are located in the rack to the left of the entrance to Christ Chapel in the narthex.

THE WEDNESDAY EUCHARISTS are prepared by Dr. Hawkins and the preacher. One of the assigned Senior Divinity Candidates will serve at the Altar and the other will prepare the community's prayers for the Wednesday morning eucharist. The lector for the day might well be a member of the wider seminary community, including family and staff members who are available. It is important that the lector should practice IN THE CHAPEL to insure a good volume, pace of reading, etc. Both readings will be from the pulpit. The CANTOR is assigned by Mr. Johnson [usually from the choir].

ONE day should be scheduled for *sung* MORNING PRAYER of the ELW, the LBW, or GATHER.

ONE day should be scheduled for the UNITED METHODIST MORNING PRAYER AND PRAISE, the EPISCOPAL MORNING PRAYER or NOONDAY PRAYER or the LBW SERVICE OF THE WORD.

ONE day should be RESPONSIVE PRAYER / SUFFRAGES [Lutheran or Episcopal rites].

ONE day should be a "free day" which would reflect EVANGELICAL / BAPTIST PATTERNS of worship, or using the resources of *This Far by Faith*.

Taizé resources might be used for any of the services.
